

COVID-19: How Perennia is Adjusting How We Work

As of May 27th, Perennia has started limited restart scenarios for on-farm visits. This means our Agriculture Field Staff are now permitted to conduct emergency farm calls, trials and monitoring programs. To ensure that we are working with our community in a way that maintains the health and safety for all, we have developed an “Operating in Partnership Under COVID-19” agreement for review before we enter the farm.

Our Agriculture Services Team continues to work remotely, which means that our in-person services are limited, but we are available to help with your needs.
